

PRIVACY POLICY

INTRODUCTION

Havrion, LLC (“**Havrion**,” “**we**,” “**our**” and “**us**”) is concerned about privacy issues and wants you to be familiar with how we collect, use and disclose information. This Privacy Policy (this “**Policy**”) describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you install, access or use HAVRION Hub (HHUB) (our “**Software**”) or visit the website at which our Software is located (our “**Portal**”) and discusses our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, correcting, deleting and disclosing that information.

Please read this Policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. This Policy applies to any personal information, and, in certain applicable instances, other information, collected through our Software or on our Portal. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, then your choice is not to install, access or use our Software and not to visit our Portal. By installing, accessing or using our Software or visiting our Portal, you agree to this Policy. This Policy may change from time to time (see **CHANGES TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY**). Your access or use of our Software or visitation of our Portal after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check this Policy periodically for updates.

This Policy does not apply to information we collect from our software applications associated with our Software or our Portal. Our software applications associated with our Software or our Portal have their own privacy policies, which we encourage you to read before providing information on or through them.

This Policy does not apply to information we collect through means other than our Software or our Portal, including, without limitation, through our other technology solutions. Our other technology solutions, including, without limitation, our other software and websites have their own privacy policies, which we encourage you to read before providing information on or through them.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU

When we collect information from you, our primary goal is to provide you with an efficient and personalized experience. We collect information about you, including personal information, from the information you voluntarily provide to us, automatic data collection technology when you access and use our Software or visit our Portal and our affiliates and third parties who may provide your information to us. Personal information that you may voluntarily provide to us, includes, without limitation, the following:

- name;
- e-mail address;

- phone number;
- mailing address
- country of residence;
- user name;
- password;
- deployment location;
- location data with respect to the geolocation fenced area that you have assigned; and
- any other personal information that may be voluntarily provided.

When you access and use our Software or visit our Portal, we may automatically collect certain details of your access to and use of our Software or visitation of our Portal. Information that we collect through automatic data collection technology includes, without limitation, information about your device, internet connection, location data and internet protocol (“IP”) address, operating system, browser type and telecommunications network information. When you access and use our Software or visit our Portal, we may automatically collect certain details of your access to and use of our Software and visitation of our Portal.

Our Software and our Portal collect real-time location information within the geolocation fenced area that you have assigned, specifically, the longitudes and latitudes within the geofence.

If you submit any personal information relating to other people (including, without limitation, your employees, contractors, representatives and agents) to us in connection with our Software or our Portal, then you represent and warrant that you have the authority to do so and to permit us to use the information in accordance with this Policy.

If you do not want us to collect this information, then do not install, use or access our Software or visit our Portal. For more information, see **HOW WE MAY USE YOUR INFORMATION AND DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION**. Note, however, that opting out of our Software or our Portal’s collection of location information will disable its location-based features.

HOW WE MAY COLLECT YOUR INFORMATION

We may collect information in several ways, including:

- **Directly from you:** When you fill-out the order form for the Software and when you register to access and use the Software and visit the Portal, you will be providing us with information, including personal information. If you contact us, then we may collect information, including personal information, through records and copies of your correspondence with us. We may also collect information, including personal information, when you respond to our questions via e-mail or feedback forms. If we collect information directly from you, then you may have the option to refuse to provide us with such information. However, if you decline to provide us information, then this may impact your ability to access and use our Software and our Portal.

- **Offline:** You may provide information, including personal information, to us when you contact a Software or Portal representative.
- **Through tokens:** A software token is a piece of a two-factor authentication security device that may be used to authorize the use of computer services. Software tokens are stored on a general-purpose electronic device, such as a desktop computer, laptop, PDA, or mobile phone, and can be duplicated. Software tokens allow our Software and our Portal to serve the user with specific information tied to the user (such as name and e-mail address) and help facilitate a quick and automatic authentication when accessing our Software and our Portal.
- **Through server log files:** Like most standard software and websites, our Software and our Portal use log files to collect information about your device and internet connection, which may include information about your IP address, browser type, internet service provider, platform type, and date/time stamp. This information may be used to analyze trends, administer our Software or our Portal, track your movement in the aggregate, and gather broad demographic information for aggregate use.
- **Through internet tags:** Internet tags are smaller than cookies and tell our server information such as the IP address and browser type related to your device.
- **From our affiliates and third parties:** We may receive information, including personal information, from our affiliates and third parties.
- **Automatically:** Our Software and our Portal collect real-time location information within the geolocation fenced area that you have assigned.

We will rely on consent, which in some cases may be implied, to use technical information that is collected through our use of cookies, server log files or internet tags. You may withdraw such consent at any time by contacting us as described in this Policy. When we obtain personal information through a third party, the third party supplying such personal information is responsible for the management of consent, where required.

The information we collect automatically is statistical data and may, depending on applicable law, include personal information, and we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from our affiliates or third parties. It helps us to improve our Software and our Portal by, among other things, enabling us to recognize you when you return to our Software or our Portal and store information about your preferences.

HOW WE MAY USE YOUR INFORMATION

To the extent permitted by applicable law, we may use information, including personal information, that we collect:

- to accomplish the actions or transactions you initiate through our Software or our Portal;
- to respond to and act upon Software or Portal support inquires and requests;
- to fulfill our obligations;
- to improve our existing, or develop new, services;
- to notify you of any specials, new products or services, or changes to this Policy;

- to supply information to you upon your request;
- to present our Software and our Portal and their contents to you in a fashion customized to match your preferences;
- to personalize your experience when accessing or using our Software or visiting our Portal;
- to help facilitate a quick and automatic authentication when you access our Software and our Portal;
- to allow you to use location-based functionality on our Software and our Portal;
- to allow you to participate in interactive features on our Software and our Portal;
- to support our business such as Software or Portal support, data analysis, IT services, customer service and other services;
- to promote our own products or services;
- to carry out obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contract entered into between you and us;
- to pursue our legitimate interests;
- to comply with legal process;
- to respond to request from public and government authorities;
- to enforce or apply our terms of use www.havrion.com/terms-and-conditions and other agreements that we may have with you;
- to allow us to pursue available remedies or limit the damages that we sustain;
- to protect our operations or those of any of our affiliates; and
- to protect our rights, privacy, safety or property, and that of our affiliates, you or others.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

To the extent permitted by applicable law, your personal information may be disclosed:

- to our affiliates for the purposes described in this Policy and to support our business such as Software or Portal support, data analysis, IT services, customer service and other services;
- to contractors, service providers, and other third parties who we use to support our business such as Software or Portal support, data analysis, IT services, customer service and other services;
- to any third party in the event of any reorganization, merger, sale, joint venture, assignment, transfer or other disposition of any or all portion of our business, assets or stock, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding;
- to comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request;
- to enforce or apply our terms of use www.havrion.com/terms-and-conditions and other agreements that we may have with you;
- if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of us, our affiliates or others;

- with your consent; and
- for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.

We will not disclose or sell any personal information to any unaffiliated third party for direct marketing purposes without your consent.

THIRD PARTY WEBSITES

Our Software and our Portal contain links to various third party websites to, among other things, support our business such as Software and Portal support, data analysis, IT services, customer service and other services. These third party websites may collect personal information. This Policy does not address, and we are not responsible for, the privacy, information or other practices of any third party, including any third party operating any site to which our Software or our Portal contains a link. The inclusion of a link on our Software or our Portal does not imply endorsement of the linked site by us or any of our affiliates.

CHOICES AND ACCESS

We strive to provide you with choices regarding our use and disclosure of your personal information. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your personal information:

- If at any time you wish to stop receiving communication from us, please just let us know by contacting us via our email address or phone number listed below (see **CONTACT INFORMATION**).
- If you block the use of location information, some parts of our Software or our Portal may become inaccessible or not function properly.

To review, correct, update, delete or otherwise limit our use of your personal information (such as behavioral tracking), please contact us using the email address or phone number listed below (see **CONTACT INFORMATION**).

SECURITY

When users submit sensitive information via our Software or our Portal, their information is protected both online and offline. Prevention of unauthorized access or disclosure of data is of the utmost importance. Physical, administrative and technical procedures are employed to safeguard all collected information.

All data transactions between you and us through our Software and our Portal occurring over a public network (i.e. the Internet) are encrypted using SSL technology. Specific certifier details can be inspected in your browser during a secure session (see browser-specific help for details).

Access to personal information and data by our employees is limited to those persons or agents of our company that have a specific business purpose for maintaining and processing such personal information. These individuals are made aware of their responsibilities to protect the security of that personal information and uphold the principles of confidentiality and integrity.

The safety and security of information also depends on you. Where we have given you (or where you have chosen) a password for access to certain parts of our Software or our Portal, you are responsible for keeping this password confidential. Please do not share your password with anyone. Sharing of account passwords is considered an acceptable use violation and may result in loss of access to our Software and our Portal.

Unfortunately, new vulnerabilities arise in the realm of technology every day. Although we strive to protect your information, circumstances beyond our control may compromise that goal and, accordingly, we cannot guarantee the absolute security of your information. RETENTION PERIOD

We may retain your personal information for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Policy, unless a longer retention period is required or allowed by law or to otherwise fulfill a legal obligation.

CHANGES TO OUR PRIVACY POLICY

If we decide to change this Policy, then we will post any changes we make or a new privacy policy on this page with a notice that the Policy has been updated and/or notify you by email to the primary email address specified in your account and/or with an in-Software or on-Portal alert the first time you access and use the Software or visit the Portal after we make the change, respectively. Any changes to this Policy will become effective when we post the revised Policy. The effective date for this Policy is identified at the top of this Policy. You are responsible for periodically accessing and using our Software or visiting our Portal and this Policy to check for any changes. Your access or use of our Software or visitation to our Portal following these changes means that you accept the revised Policy.

CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 13

Neither our Software nor our Portal is intended for children under 13 years of age and we do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13 years of age. In the event that we learn that we have collected personal information from a child under 13 years of age, we will delete such personal information as soon as possible. USERS FROM THE EUROPEAN UNION AND SWITZERLAND

This section of this Policy applies to users of our Software and our Portal from a Member State of the European Union or Switzerland, and supplements the other information in this Policy.

LAWFULNESS OF PROCESSING

CROSS-BORDER TRANSFER

When Personal Data is transferred out of the country where the owner of that Personal Data lives, such as from citizens of the European Union and Switzerland to the United States of America, different standards may apply to how your Personal Data is used and protected in those countries. We have safeguards in place in accordance with applicable legal requirements, including, without limitation, obtaining written assurances from any third party given access to your Personal Data so as to require them to adopt standards that ensure an equivalent level of protection for Personal Data as that adopted by Havrion. If you prefer not to have your Personal Data transferred, then do not install, access or use our Software or visit our Portal.

YOUR RIGHTS

If you are in the European Union or Switzerland, then you also have the right to request access to, rectify, or erase your Personal Data. You also have a right to the objection to or restriction of processing, as well as the right to data portability, when applicable. If Havrion has processed your Personal Data based on your consent, then you have a right to withdraw it at any time. When we receive a request from you to exercise one of these rights, we will respond to your request as quickly as possible, and, in any event, in accordance with applicable legal requirements.
